Dear Ms. Gumaer:

I am writing to follow up on the Review Board's March 9, 1998 letter to the Air Force in which we requested the Air Force to undertake certain additional measures under the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992 ("JFK Act"). See March 9, 1998 letter from J. Gunn to C. Gumaer. To date, we have received no communication from the Air Force as to whether it has pursued these matters.

It is essential that the Air Force address, as soon as possible, these remaining issues under the JFK Act, including our request for a Supplemental Declaration as to the Air Force's compliance with the JFK Act (we had asked that this be submitted by May 1998, but we have not received anything). The Review Board's mandate expires on September 30, 1998, and we wish to make a complete accounting of the work of the Air Force in our Final Report to the President.

Your immediate attention to this matter is appreciated.
