Dear Deputy Chief Day:

I am writing on behalf of the Review Board's Executive Director, David Marwell, in response to Sheriff Lee's letter of June. We appreciate Sheriff Lee's gracious response; I look forward to speaking with you further about any records that may be in Sheriff's files related to President Kennedy's assassination.

The type of records which I think you may have may be largely of an intelligence nature relating to several topics, including the activities of anti-Castro groups operating in your parish and surrounding areas in the early 1960's; intelligence on Jefferson Parish residents who might be involved in anti-Castro or pro-Castro groups (in the latter category, for example, the Fair Play for Cuba Committee) and Organized Crime activity in the Parish in the early 1960's. The Review Board would also seek any records in your files created during Jim Garrison's investigation and prosecution of the alleged Kennedy assassination conspiracy in the 1960's. There may very well be other areas of records which I have not mentioned here, or which you identify in your own review of the files.

Thank you for conducting a review of the Sheriff's files in these and related topic areas and for contacting me when you have had a chance to do so. My extension and voice mail number is 229. Thank you in advance for your time and cooperation on this matter. I look forward to speaking with you soon.
