Dear Dr. Murrah:

This letter is to confirm our telephone conversation of Monday, August 28, 1995, concerning the papers of Waggoner Carr, Congressman Mahon, and the audio tapes collection of George McClendon.

We agreed during that conversation that the Review Board will pay to have one set of microfilms made of the Carr papers, and will further pay the photocopying costs associated with the Mahon papers that you identify as assassination related. We agreed that while it was important for the JFK Collection to have copies of Congressman Mahon's notes, made the day of the assassination or shortly thereafter, it was not necessary to copy his many non-assassination-related records. We also agreed that you would make the appropriate contacts to determine if copies of Mr. McClendon's recordings can be included in the JFK Collection.

My understanding was that you would assemble information about the McClendon matter and would include this in a letter that would also indicate when the Carr microfilm and Mahon photocopies will be shipped. Please include an invoice for the costs of the latter two and I will submit it for prompt payment.

Thank you for your assistance and cooperation. I look forward to receiving your letter and the microfilm and copies soon.
