He was born on August 5, 1930, in Greenwich, New York. He served on Active Duty in the United States Army from 1948 through 1959 and was a decorated Korean War hero (he was awarded the Purple Heart three times and the Bronze Star, I am told.)

Thank you for sending a photocopy of his record to my attention at the Review Board.
