I am writing to follow up on our lunch meeting conversation on July 24 concerning sources of assassination records that you and Mr. Sanders identified in your law review article that you believe the Review Board should be looking into. I told you at that meeting that I would reread the article and write to you for more information on sources of records that the Board will attempt to pursue. Please regard this letter as the Board's request for any and all information you are able to provide, based on your research or other sources you are aware of, for the following individuals or sources:

- 1) Eugene Dinkin, an American serviceman stationed in France in 1963.
- 2) Richard Case Nagell.
- 3) Robert Morrow.
- 4) Three (3) arrest reports uncovered in February 1993 at the Dallas Police Department allegedly concerning the "three tramps." Please indicate who uncovered these reports (which I was already aware of) and all additional information you can provide.

I recall, Mark, that your closing comment to me was that you felt you had to "prod" the Review Board to conduct searches for assassination records. I found your choice of words and sentiment unfortunate. You are certainly aware that the Review Board and its staff are working diligently to meet the Congressional mandate to identify and review all public and private sector assassination records. While the Review Board appreciates your interest and assistance in this work, as they
