

5. Specific attention is directed to the activities of the Mexican authorities described in the diplomatic notes to the United States Ambassador from the Mexican Department of Foreign Relations dated May 10, 1964, and June 9, 1964. These activities include:
 - (a) closure of the border by the Department of the Interior on November 22, 1963;
 - (b) deployment of troops that same date “to tighten surveillance in the border area, especially at Reynosa, Ciudad Miguel Aleman, Nuevo Laredo, and Matamoros;” and
 - (c) investigation of Oswald’s trip to Mexico City in September/October 1963, and especially of his means of entering and exiting Mexico and his contacts with Silvia Tirado Duran, an employee of the Cuban Consulate in Mexico City.
