Dear Ms. McMillan:

On behalf of the Assassination Records Review Board, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the cooperation that you have provided to the Board.

As a follow-up to Tom Samoluk's recent review of your records, I would like to propose a plan which would allow for you to achieve your desire of donating your records to the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection (JFK Collection), while still maintaining copies of materials that are important to your continuing review of events related to the assassination.

First, we would ask you to identify any records which are important for you and of which you would like to have copies in your possession. Second, we would arrange for the transfer of all of your records to our offices in Washington for processing and eventual inclusion in the JFK Collection at the National Archives. Third, the donation would be made under a Deed of Gift. As a condition of the donation, the Review Board would agree to provide you with copies of the records which you have identified. Under this proposed plan, your records would become part of the Collection sooner and be available to the public, and you would have the records which you would need. Our view is that your records would be an important addition to the JFK Collection. We are anxious to add them to the Collection as soon as possible to allow public access. Please review the proposal which I have outlined above. Any suggestions that you have would be greatly appreciated.

Again, thank you for all that you have done to assist the Review Board in attempting to fulfill its mandate. I look forward to hearing from in the near future.
