Dear Mrs. Boggs:

On behalf of the Assassination Records Review Board, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for agreeing to testify at our public hearing in New Orleans on Wednesday, June 28, 1995. Your presence at the hearing will greatly enhance interest in the Board's efforts and our credibility as we seek to identify, secure, and make available to the American public all records related to the assassination of President Kennedy.

The public hearing will be conducted at the Old U.S. Mint Building, located at 400 Esplanade Avenue, and will begin at 10:00 a.m. Because the Board will hear from you and other witnesses as one of the first items on the agenda, we ask that you arrive at 9:45 a.m., if possible. After introductory remarks by Mr. John R. Tunheim, Chair of the Review Board, you will be called as the first witness.

Per your previous conversations with Tom Samoluk of the Review Board staff, it would be of great assistance to us if, during your testimony, you stated your support of the Board's efforts and the importance of preserving the historical record of the assassination. In addition, it would set a positive tone if you publicly stated that you were allowing the Board access to your late husband's papers at Tulane University that relate to the assassination and his service on the Warren Commission. The Board would also like to extend to you the opportunity to submit a prepared written statement that would be made available on the day of the hearing and would become part of the permanent record of the public hearing. If you choose to provide us with a written statement, it would be helpful for us to receive it by Wednesday, June 21, 1995.
