Dear Mr. Wallace:

Thank you for your letter of June 26, 1995 to Mr. John Tunheim, Chair of the Review Board. He has asked me to respond to you.

First, I have enclosed the FBI report on the interview of Lillian Mooneyham, dated January 10, 1964, which was printed on page 531 of Volume XXIV of the Warren Commission Report.

Second, I suggest that you contact the National Archives to learn what information is publicly available from the records of the House Select Committee on Assassinations. If following contact with the National Archives you garner information about records that you believe exist but have not been acknowledged or would like to recommend specific records that should be reviewed by the Board on a priority basis, please write to us again. Your reference to a record relative to the Tom Dillard photograph

was not specific enough to determine whether or not this is a document known by you to exist or one that you assume exists.

Third, we appreciate your suggestion with regard to seeking testimony in connection with the Dillard photograph.

Fourth, your request for "an official investigative report of this facial image in Dillard's photograph by the Federal Bureau of Investigation" is unclear. Again, if you are seeking a specific record which you believe exists, the National Archives should be contacted first. If your request is for the Review Board to ask the FBI to undertake an analysis of the Dillard photograph, that is beyond the scope of the legal mandate of

the Board. The Review Board is not reinvestigating the assassination. Under the law, Board is to compile all of the records relative to the assassination that exist and make them available to the American public at the National Archives.
