Dear Ms. Veazey:

Per our conversation, I have enclosed a copy of the film which you donated to the President John F. Kennedy Assassination Records Collection at the National Archives, through the Assassination Records Review Board.

The enclosed videotape is the first copy made from the 16 mm film. In chronological terms the second film appears first on this tape. The copy was made while the film was being viewed for the first time and the order of sequences was not known. Nevertheless, I thought you would like the first copy that was made.

Please note that there is a notice on the tape and a letter enclosed with it regarding copyright claims which were made on May 28, 1996 when the attorneys for KTVT learned that we had the tape and intended to distribute it. We felt it was necessary to advise people who received copies of the film of this claim and also wanted you to know about it. KTVT has not contacted us again regarding this matter at the time of this letter and has given no further indication that they intend to pursue it.

Again, on behalf of the Review Board, thank you for the donation and all of your cooperation. I will provide additional information and the Deed of Gift for the film once it is completed.
