Thank you for your June 10, 1997 letter. I have enclosed an information packet about the Assassination Records Review Board.

The Review Board was established by the JFK Assassination Records Collection Act of 1992. The Board was created to oversee the identification and release of records related to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy.

Once the Board votes to release assassination-related records, the documents are transferred to the National Archives and Records Administration for inclusion in the JFK Assassination Records Collection. We do not keep the documents in our offices.

I hope the information packet is helpful to you. There are some articles that may be of use to you, but as you will see, they are primarily about the work of the Review Board and documents that it has released, as opposed to general information about the assassination.

We do not work with documents related to the Lincoln assassination.

Please let me know if I can be of further assistance to you.
