Thank you for your May 30, 1997 letter.

The Review Board received from David Lifton a copy of the Zapruder film. This particular copy is a 35 millimeter interpositive.

In Mr. Lifton's testimony (enclosed) to the Review Board at its September 17, 1996 hearing in Los Angeles, he said, "That is, this 35 millimeter interpositive can be the progenitor of many millimeter internegatives and they in turn can be used to create 35 millimeter positives, whether they be slides or motion picture film."

Mr. Lifton donated this copy to the Review Board for inclusion in the JFK Collection at the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA.) It will be transferred to NARA pending a Deed of Gift.
