Subject: ARRB Review of FBI File on the Mexico City Legat (HQ 64-4532)

The ARRB staff has completed its review of Sections 21, 22, 23, and 24 of the above-referenced file.

We found no material in Section 21 that we believe should be processed under the JFK Act; however, in our view, the following documents from the other Sections should be processed as assassination records under the JFK Act:

Section 22

serial 1828 dated April 30, 1962 (Director to Legat, Mexico City)

Section 23

serial 1918 dated Dec. 3, 1963 (Legat, Mexico City to Director)

serial 1967 dated March 6, 1964 (Legat, Mexico City to Director)

NR serial dated April 15, 1964 (Branigan to Sullivan)

NR serial dated May 13, 1964 (Legat, Mexico City to Director, FBI)

Section 24

serial 1984 dated July 29, 1964 (Brennan to Sullivan)

serial 1985 dated July 7, 1964 (Legat, Mexico City to Director)

NR serial dated April 6, 1965 (Legat, Mexico City to Director)

These documents are tabbed on the copies of these Sections we are returning to you.

Please advise whether the FBI agrees to process these documents as assassination records under the JFK Act. To the extent that the FBI and the ARRB staff cannot agree on whether these documents should be reviewed under the JFK Act, the ARRB staff will present them to the Review Board to make a formal determination on this issue.
