Subject: Suggested Talking Points on FBI Release

1. This release is another important step towards fulfilling the mandate of the 1992 law requiring government agencies to open up their JFK files.
2. This release is important because it helps to round out the record of the assassination.
3. Any records related to Cuba and Castro are of interest because they have been part of much of the controversy surrounding the assassination.
4. Our role is not to evaluate the records. Our role is to ensure that the American public gets to see the assassination records.
5. The Review Board will be reviewing records that agencies do not want to release at this time.
6. The Review Board is about openness, not secrecy. The American public can expect more records to be released in the future as the Board continues the review of documents.
