I will contact you regarding a written statement, which we discussed in Santa Monica. As I mentioned, it will be important to complete our files to have such a document.

Again, thank you for all of your assistance. I enjoyed having dinner with you, Larry and Bob. I look forward to hearing from you if you learn of any developments regarding assassination records.
