Subject is the Cuban intelligence officer who recently defected [redacted] Austin Horn, CIA, furnished the following to the Liaison Agent on 4/27/64: *(S)(u)*

A CIA representative travelled to Canada on 4/24/64 to interview the subject. This interview was subsequently conducted in collaboration with the [redacted]. Preliminary reports indicate that subject's knowledge of Cuban intelligence activities is restricted to Central and South America. He has not furnished any information concerning intelligence activity in the U. S. The interview has not been completed and CIA anticipates that subject should have considerable information pertaining to the Cuban intelligence organization in Cuba. *(S)*

As of 4/27/64 CIA was taking steps to arrange for subject's entry into the U. S. If his entry is arranged through INS, CIA will continue with the interrogation in the Washington, D. C. area. *(S)(u)*

The Liaison Agent has requested that the Bureau be immediately apprised of any information of interest to the Bureau.
