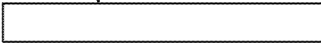

MEMORANDUM FOR: Director of Security

SUBJECT: Robert A. Maheu and Associates (RAMA)

1. In line with your request, there is listed below CCS use for operational purposes of Robert A. Maheu and Associates:

a. Various officers of the CCS have been in contact with Robert A. Maheu (RAM) since 1954. The reasons for these meetings were at all times to determine the feasibility of using Maheu's firm for [redacted] purposes.

b. [redacted] use of RAMA was for:

(1) CIA employee from June <sup>1950</sup> ~~1960~~ to August <sup>1950</sup> ~~1960~~, apparently for a TDY to India, Thailand and Malaysia. No other information is immediately available.

(2) CIA employee as employee in Maheu's Washington office from September 1964 to June 1966.

(3) CIA employee

a. As Maheu Associates representative in [redacted] from 1 August 1968 thru 31 December 1970. CIA employee is now in Washington, D. C. after having sent a letter of resignation effective 31 December 1970 to RAM's office in Las Vegas, including a check (cashier's) -- equivalent to \$10,000 in [redacted] currency -- which Maheu had deposited some years ago in connection with an aborted cable TV venture.

b. Initially, CIA employee was to go to [redacted] on a lateral transfer as tentatively agreed with Peter Maheu, the designated contact point for CIA. In early December after the first round of publicity on Robert Maheu's court battles, Peter Maheu was informed that CIA employee would not return to the WH area, and we considered his transfer to [redacted] cancelled.
