Thinks he travelled to India 1 or 2 times per year, 2 or 3 times to Paris & 1-2 times per year in London, & 1 or less times per yr in Rome. Only domestic travel in 63 wd have been to NY. All travel done in his own name.

On 22 Nov '63, he & wife were driving on H St & got in Wash. D.C. when heard on Car radio. Had been in Chinese grocery store. On way home to 5215 Ballou Rd, Summer, Md. Drove home after stopping at Sidwell <sup>Friends</sup> School & picked up younger daughter Kevin Hunt. Robert & Courtney

[Redacted] remembers that Robt Kennedy's children, in same school, had been picked up from school by Secret Service & the children knew abt assass.
