Summary of " [redacted] Development and Plans " file

1. "Subject + Project File Request and Field Notification of Action" dated 6/26/63 describes the project as "a Developmental and Target Opportunity project based in the U.S. Sub-projects are to be targeted abroad."
2. Project Action form dated 8/28/63 signed by Karamessines approves a \$65,000 budget for <sup>CRYPT Project</sup> [redacted] for the fiscal year 1963 (July) to 1964 (June).
4. Memo dated 3/17/64 to DPP from Tracy Barnes requests that <sup>Project crypt</sup> [redacted]'s budget be increased to \$80,000.  
 "The requested increase is needed to (a) cover an unanticipated developmental charge in connection with an individual doing <sup>SPECIAL</sup> work involving a Latin American

business advisory group;  
(b) covers the production  
costs of propaganda material
