WEEKLY AIRTEL SUMMARY

ReBulet dated 4/26/62.

The Chicago Office has advised [redacted] (Protect; symbol number of the Chicago Office) advised February 28 and March 31, 1962 that he had been in contact in Tampa in the past with FRANK DIECIDUE, whom he described as related, he believed, to SANTO TRAFFICANTE. This source described SANTO as being a leading figure in gambling in Miami where SANTO was associated with a DAVE YAROS, formerly of Chicago, Illinois.

OTHER 4

DAVID M. SCHWARTZ, CPA, (Protect), advised on April 17, 1962, that he had been an accountant for the TRAFFICANTE family in Tampa, Florida, since approximately 1957, noting he did not do much work for SANTO when SANTO was operating in Cuba.

Source noted the TRAFFICANTE CPA, DAVID M. SCHWARTZ, only prepares tax returns, having no access to any books, but is merely supplied summaries of their financial transactions from which his tax returns are made. Source noted that SCHWARTZ had recently gained a six-months extension for SANTO
