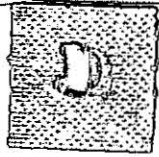

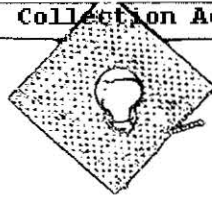

Re Miami airtel to Baltimore, <sup>IO</sup>4/17/69; Baltimore letter to Miami, <sup>IO</sup>6/2/69; Baltimore letter to Director, 6/27/69; Bureau airtel dated 7/9/69. <sup>see 30</sup>

In the initial communication from Miami to Baltimore, it was stated that the receiving offices should furnish the identifying data to Miami who would then incorporate that information in a LHM for submission to the Bureau for RCMP. Subsequently, Baltimore made this information available to Miami by letter. The Bureau then directed Baltimore to submit a LHM incorporating this information which was done by Baltimore letter to Bureau, 6/27/69.

Baltimore has never received any communication from the New Haven Office concerning this matter. It is suggested that the office of origin in CELLINI case, the Miami Office, could possibly have received this New Haven communication.
