No mention of "minute men" has been noted in the newspapers published in the Biloxi RA Territory to indicate a chapter of this organization has been started nearby.

On 11/30/61, Chief of Police E. F. WETZEL, advised he had received no information to indicate a chapter of this organization operating at Biloxi or vicinity.

On 11/29/61, NO-995C and PCI [redacted] stated they had no information regarding any such organization.
