Subject: Analysis of IRPENT Traffic Relating to LIRING/3 Operation.
for the Period 8-28 June, 1967.

1. Traffic for the period indicated was reviewed by Rowton and found to confirm reports given to him at regular meetings by LIRING/3 and LIRING/4. In addition several items of interest were supplied for additional background information.
2. SAN-32 (erroneously marked SAN-22) indicates that on 13 June, 1967, Max Figueroa called for LIRING/3 from the Cuban Embassy. Another call was made on 14 June in the morning (prior to 1130) leaving a message that "the Minister wanted to see LIRING/3. LIRING/4 also received messages from Adis (Valdes) of the Consulate on 13 and 20 June, 1967.
3. SAN-32 (14/6/67) reveals a call from Jacobo Rodriguez Padilla to LIRING/4 asking for L/3. Jacobo states that his son was in Guatemala for fifteen days to arrange his stay there as a student. Jacobo also states that "someone saw Enrique Morales" in Guatemala - this indicates that Morales is known to Jacobo (probably through Morales' wife).
4. SAN-34 (19 June) reveals that LIRING/3 is continuing his meetings with sra Silvia Durán. (Rowton had shown no interest in this contact and it appears that L/3 is developing a romantic attachment to sra Durán). This same reel also contains a conversation between L/3 and his half-sister Emma [redacted] regarding "papers". L/3 had explained to Rowton that he hoped to obtain his half brother Sergio's original birth-certificate from Sergio's sister Emma to give the certificate to Jacobo Rodriguez Padilla. The intercept reveals Emma's address as [redacted] and a place where she visits often as the Encuadernación Versailles, Republica de Salvador 29, where she goes with a certain "Anita".
5. SAN-36 (27/6/67) reveals that the home telephone of Raúl Moreno is 39-90-03 since Raúl Moreno telephoned home from the safehouse. The same reel contains the telephone call from L/3 to René Cochca in Havana which generally confirms L/3's report to Rowton.
