MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD

SUBJECT: RU-449 -- "Strategic Medical Significance of Lysergic Acid Diethylamide (LSD-25) and Relative Compounds"

1. Subject was discussed this date with the Chief, IPS, with the following results:

a. The subject manuscript has been withdrawn from Intelligence Board consideration upon the recommendation of the Chief, Support Staff. The recommendation was concurred in by the AD/SI and Chief, IPS. Memorandum dated 5 May 1955, subject as above, to all members of the OSI Intelligence Board from the vice-chairman of the Board, was thereby rescinded.

b. The paper is to be published as an "OSI Study" rather than an SIR or other authorized type of publication.

c. Dissemination will be closely controlled and limited to those whose designations are listed in the rescinded memorandum noted in para. 1a above.

d. Following publication, the Deputy Director of Security will be queried on whether a copy can be supplied to ~~Gen. P. O. Reynolds~~ ^{Gen. P. O. Reynolds}, Chief Research & Development Division, Office of the Surgeon General, Main Navy Building.
