1. On 21 March 1950 [REDACTED] commented on the investigation at which he and [REDACTED] (on different days) had testified. C

2. On my question as to his opinion of [REDACTED] he stated that he had been very favorably impressed both by [REDACTED]'s ideas and by their method of presentation. C

3. He had reached this conclusion from press reports of the case, from his own reading of [REDACTED]'s contributions on the psychiatry of panic states; had not actually heard his testimony.
