 [redacted] defined the specific "ultimate"
 objectives we would wish to achieve from the project. [redacted] will discuss this with [redacted] and determine his willingness to enter into contract to meet these objectives, or his feeling as to what objectives he can meet with the funds allotted. This step is necessary because the [redacted] proposal was vague, indicating only lines of research to be followed. Until specific aims are agreed upon, the Agency is not committed. Additional restrictions readily agreed to by [redacted] are that the project will be reported only as development of side-tone delay for para-psychological purposes; that knowledge of CIA sponsorship will not be revealed; and that all reports will be retained for CIA use only, until screened and released by us. [redacted] will contact [redacted] on the next step in the project.
