1. Memorandum on the use of MT-25 received from [redacted]

2. Arrangements made with [redacted] assigned to meet with [redacted] Thursday a.m., (time to be established later by [redacted])

3. A meeting of the [redacted] Business for Project Artichoke established for Thursday, 21 January at 2:00 p.m., [redacted] to be present. Purpose of the meeting is to review the research projects now going on and discuss means of achieving closer coordination.

4. [redacted] advised that another individual [redacted] is interested in Artichoke matters. He is [redacted] and according to [redacted] is a more logical [redacted] than [redacted]

Comment: [redacted] is probably in the operational end of [redacted] intelligence and contact with him may be more productive than with [redacted] who although very cooperative, has so far contributed nothing to the Project.

5. [redacted] has set up a meeting with [redacted] assistant at 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, 23 January in [redacted] office. The purpose of the meeting is to provide a direct and efficient channel for communications between CIA and the [redacted] on Artichoke matters and principally the [redacted]

6. In a meeting with [redacted] of the combined [redacted] organization, the question of Artichoke representation for those offices was discussed. [redacted] agreed to look into the matter and advise us whether we continue to deal with [redacted] arrangement or whether there will be a new designee to represent all operational interests.
