1. Forwarded herewith is the psychiatrist's report on the examination of [REDACTED]. It will be seen in paragraph 4 of the attachment that we are dealing with a person whose suicidal tendency may come to the fore again at any time. We are therefore cancelling the long-range plan we had for an [REDACTED] operation and intend to fill him with garbage and send him back into [REDACTED] the way he came out. The psychiatrist feels strongly that there is little doubt that [REDACTED] has told the truth to the [REDACTED] interrogator about his [REDACTED] mission. However, as will be noted in paragraph 5 of the attachment, he is equally likely to tell the truth to his [REDACTED] interrogator, and for this reason we cannot expect to go beyond handing the [REDACTED] a long interrogation job and some notional leads which they will feel bound to follow up.
