b. It should be completely secure.

c. It should, if possible, be large enough to provide living accompositions for all the personnel involved—it members of the team (at least), the Subject, case officers (the number of which should be kept as low as possible), and sufficient guards to maintain a 24-hour watch.

d. The working area must consist of two bedrooms, preferably with an adjoining bath, or with bath close by. These rooms should be on the second floor of the house, and should be well furnished, preferably with rugs on the floors.

e. Personnel involved in the actual operation must have their seals in the house.
