SUBJECT : Request for ARTICEKE

1. This memorandum contains a request submitted for ID/P approval. Each request is contained in paragraph 2.

2. [REDACTED] requests permission to use ARTICEKE in the anticipated interrogation of [REDACTED]. Although straight interrogation methods would be used initially, we should be prepared to use ARTICEKE should regular means fail. [REDACTED] could be taken to [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] for the ARTICEKE phase which could be administered under medical cover. A [REDACTED] speaking CIA case officer is available in [REDACTED] as an interpreter.

4. If ARTICEKE is used, [REDACTED] agrees not to reinfiltre [REDACTED] regardless of the outcome of the interrogation. The agent could be held in safe-keeping by a [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] for an indefinite period of time. If, contrary to all indications, the operation proves to be clean, another agent could be reinfiltred to replace [REDACTED].
