Subject: SI and H Experimentation, 9 February 1954.

On Tuesday, 9 February 1954, SI and H experimentation and research was carried on in Room 20, Building 13, by Messrs. [redacted] and [redacted] and using the following subjects: Miss [redacted], Miss [redacted] and Miss [redacted]. In addition, Miss [redacted] who had never previously worked, attended.

Since this was [redacted]'s first session, she was asked merely to observe and not to attempt to work in any of the testing. The first induction was a regular slow induction with all participating. Second induction also was a regular slow type and during this trance some tests for depth were tried. A post-hypnotic was given to insure rapid induction for the following test and this was accomplished in a matter of seconds. During this test, [redacted] moved all subjects except [redacted] out of the room and took them into the laboratory where he showed all the subjects, under hypnosis, how to take pictures using the flashgun attachment on the Contax camera. Thereafter, Mr. [redacted] returned the subjects to the Operations Room and Miss [redacted] using the camera and with only very slight assistance from [redacted] posed the other subjects and took a number of flash photographs of them. During this entire time, all subjects were under complete hypnosis. [redacted] and Mr. [redacted] and [redacted] for part of the time observed the proceedings through the two-way mirror. Upon completion of the taking of the pictures, the subjects were brought out and tests were made for amnesia. Miss [redacted] had complete amnesia for the entire activity. Miss [redacted] recalled the entire activity and Miss [redacted] had partial amnesia and a somewhat vague recall of the events.

Following the above, another rapid induction was run on all persons present and various tests, movements were carried out. Some subjects were moved around the building and others were told to make telephone calls which in turn were answered by other subjects, operating under complete hypnosis. Tests were made for amnesia and Misses [redacted] and [redacted] had total amnesia for their activities. Miss [redacted] had partial amnesia and Miss [redacted] again apparently had full recall.

The session adjourned at about 8:30.
