Dear Mr. Greenewald,

This is in reference to your 14 April 2014 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records pertaining to the use of the Extrasensory Perception (ESP). We received your FOIA request with one document from the Defense Intelligence Agency and assigned case number 2015-00062-F to it.

A classification review was conducted with the utmost diligence to determine if the record you requested may be released in whole or in part. We have determined that the record you seek is exempt from public disclosure. Listed below are the exemptions that apply to the requested document:

United States Code, Title 5, Section 552(b)(1) and Executive Order 13526, Section 1.4(c). The information is properly and currently classified, as specifically authorized under the criteria established by Executive Order 13526 and its unauthorized disclosure could reasonably be expected to cause damage to national security.

United States Code, Title 5, Section 552(b)(3), 10 U.S.C. 242. Personal and organizational information of the Defense Intelligence Agency.

Should you decide that an appeal to this decision is necessary, you must write to the Secretary of the Air Force within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter. Include in your appeal any reasons for reconsideration you wish to present and attach a copy of this letter. The appeal should be forwarded to:
