This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated 14 August 2000, received in the Information Access and Release Center of the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) on 21 August 2000. For processing purposes, we have aggregated some of your requests. Case Number F00-0082 is a request for "The List of all NRO Directives, or documents that list the directives thereof;" "The NRO Records Released Index;" "The Internal Personnel Manual(s) or Handbook(s) at NRO;" and "The list of Official Histories at NRO."

Your request was processed in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C.§ 552, as amended.

A total of six (6) pages was found to be responsive to your request for "The list of all NRO Directives . . ." and is being released to you in part. Portions of the documents are being withheld pursuant to the following FOIA exemptions:

- (b) (1), which applies to information currently and properly classified in accordance with Executive Order 12958, to include 1.5(c), intelligence activities (including special activities, and intelligence sources or methods;
- (b)(3) which allows the withholding of information prohibited from disclosure by statute, 10 U.S.C. § 424 which states: "Except as required by the President or as provided in subsection (c), no provision of law shall be construed to require the disclosure of (1) The organization or any function . . . (2) . . . number of persons employed by or assigned or detailed to any such organization or the name, official title,

occupational series, grade, or salary of any such person . . . (b) Covered Organizations . . . the National Reconnaissance Office; " and

(b)(6) which applies to records which if released would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

We do not have a "list of Official Histories at NRO."
Nor do we have an index of "NRO Records Released . . .;"
