On 11/27/79, Special Clerk (SC) [redacted] was assigned to complaint duty at WFO. At approximately 11:05 a.m., she received a call from a person identifying himself as [redacted] Cal Creek, Oregon 97410. He alluded to an assassination attempt against Senator KENNEDY which was to take place in the Pacific Northwest, but regarding which he would provide no other details.

There were 3 attempts to pick up my daughter [redacted] and put her into a car. There have been at least seven attempts to do bodily harm to myself. I have bought and sold \$30,000 worth of property equity since the summer of 1978. Mortgage foreclosure began in May of 1979. I have been slandered consistently.

I notified the F. B. I. and the Secret Service of the removal of Kennedy interests around my family and I. They verified the "presence of look-alikes to Kennedy around me but we (the F. B. I.) cannot prove what these were for." I don't think there is any question in anybody's mind but that I have been set-up in a scam to insinuate that Senator Kennedy has been involved.

I am requesting that your office approach Senator Kennedy with the possibility of my meeting with him. He, I don't believe, is aware that the man we believe to be

responsible for one of the attempts to pick up my daughter is using his name.

Ms. [redacted] first contacted the Bureau in 1979 complaining that she was being harassed by men who look like Senator Edward Kennedy although she had originally believed it was actually Senator Kennedy. On another occasion she furnished a list of license plates of individuals looking like Senator Kennedy who she claimed had attempted to run her off the road during a weekend trip.

Based on the information in Ms. [redacted] communication to you and the data she has previously furnished the Bureau, there is no indication of a violation of Federal law falling within our investigative authority. If she has not already done so, she should notify her local law enforcement authorities regarding her fear for her safety and that of her daughters and the United States Postal Service with regard to her statement that someone is tampering with her mail.

**PURPOSE:** To provide to the Criminal Investigative Division (CID) material received by staff members of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence and to recommend appropriate action.

**DETAILS:** On January 25, 1984, [Redacted] staff member, HPSCI, telephonically advised that several staff members of the Committee had received printed material through the U. S. Mail containing derogatory statements about Senator Kennedy and others. She advised that although the material did not seem to contain direct threats against the recipient's, the vituperative nature of the material caused them to be concerned that perhaps it might be an implied threat. Those receiving the material were [Redacted]. The recipients had no idea as to why they were selected to receive the material, and speculated that their addresses may have been obtained from the Congressional Staff Directory.

Based on directions from the Congressional Affairs Office (CAO) Ms. [Redacted] sent the attached material to the FBI for analysis. She stated that she did not want the material returned and that she would leave it up to the FBI as to whether or not it represented any kind of threat.
