MEMORANDUM

From: STANCICC Ad Hoc Subcommittee for Technical Conference Planning.
To: All STANCICC Subcommittees.
Ref: Secretary, STANCICC, memorandum of 14 January 1946 to Colonel Hayes and Captain Goodwin.

1. It is requested that the STANCICC subcommittees prepare and deliver to this subcommittee tentative first drafts of appropriate sections of a tentative British-U.S. agreement in accordance with the following table.




